## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (KING STREET, LUDLOW) (EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2020

Shropshire Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of their powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order shall come into effect on 26 June 2020 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (King Street, Ludlow) (Experimental Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2020.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall use, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, between the hours of 10am and 3pm, on Fridays and Saturdays.
- 3 Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful to use, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the said length of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is, or is being used:
  - a) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road of any of the following operations, namely:
    - i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
    - iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said length of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - b) in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - c) in the service of a local authority, or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker, or the Environment Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- 4. This Order may be suspended, modified or extended by the Assistant Director Infrastructure and Communities, or any person so authorised by them to do so.
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
