THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2011 (VARIOUS CAR PARKS, SHREWSBURY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER

Shropshire Council proposes to trial and introduce provisions to allow customers to pay for the appropriate daily parking charge via phone or other suitable electronic means in the following car parks in Shrewsbury:

Bridge Street - Proposed Location Code 740001 St Austin's - Proposed Location Code 740002 The Tannery - Proposed Location Code 740003 Frankwell Main - Proposed Location Code 740004

Customers wishing to use this as a method of payment of the daily parking charge will be required on first use to supply the 'Cashless Parking Provider' with the relevant registration number of the vehicle, location code of the parking place, credit or debit card details, and any other details the Council or provider may from time to time require which is accepted by the Council as a valid method of payment for the relevant time of use of the parking place.

A service charge currently set at 10p and known as the 'Convenience Charge' will be payable to the 'Cashless Parking Provider' by the customer for using the service in addition to the appropriate daily charge set by the Council. Other charges may be applied should the customer wish to purchase any additional services offered by the 'Cashless Parking Provider'. The customer will be responsible for all additional costs from the service provider of their phone, or other suitable electronic means, used in any transactions relating to purchases from the 'Cashless Parking Provider'.

From 7th April 2014 details on how to access the scheme will be available on information signs on the pay and display machines at each of the trial parking places, and registration to the 'Cashless Parking Provider' software known as MIPermit will also be made available via a link on Shropshire Council's website at www.shropshire.gov.uk/parking
